Admissions to High School and Reception

The deadline to apply for a high school place is **31st October 25**

The deadline to apply for a reception place is **15th January 26**

Credit lunches - If your child is not eligible for free school meals and orders a lunch then a daily charge of £2.91 is applied to your Parent Pay account. **Please note that payment for meals must be made in advance for a lunch to be ordered to avoid any debt accruing.** Parents can view the current menu on the school website.

If your child was in year 2 last year they will no longer be eligible for free universal school meals unless you are entitled to free school meals based on benefits. Please contact the office with any queries.

Medical - If your child has any medical needs please inform the school. **We are a 'NO NUT' school. Please do not send your child to school with food containing nuts.**

We trust you all had a wonderful summer and are ready for the new Autumn Term. We welcome our new Reception and Nursery children and their families into our community.

Housekeeping Reminders:

- * If your child is unwell please **call** or **email** the office by 9am so that we are aware your child will not be in that day. **Please do not use Dojo to communicate absence.**
- * Please remember doors open at **8:35am.** If your child's door entrance is shut they must come into school through the main office. Lessons start promptly so please make sure your child is on time.
- * Any routine medical/dental appointments should be booked after school hours when possible so children do not lose learning time
- * No smoking/vaping is permitted on school grounds **at any time**
- * Please **DO NOT** park on the yellow zig-zag road markings outside the school gates as this is dangerous for children crossing the road and causes traffic congestion.
- * **Lunch Boxes** - Should come in with your child at the start of the day. If forgotten or late please bring in by **11.45am** and put in the box provided in reception area. Please ensure your child's name and class are clearly labelled.
