On Tuesday, pupils showcased all that they had learned from Rock Steady. Thank you to those parents that attended and we hope you enjoyed the performance.

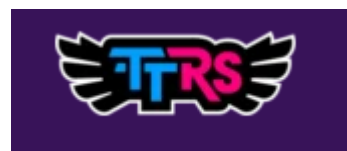
