Welcome Back to Summer Term

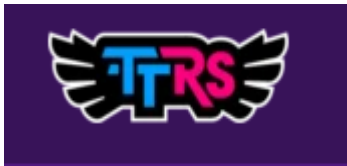
Nursery - We have new pupils join our Nursery this term. We welcome them all and their families to our school and community.
