Additional appendix for the duration of Covid-19

Additional Points:

(Incorporating government guidance during Covid-19)

- Adults and children must follow new routines for arriving and leaving the school grounds as directed by the school and staff.
- Adults and children will be respectful of the local residents when arriving and leaving the school site.
- Children and adults must move around the school site as directed.
- Instructions involving cleaning hands, using the toilets and other hygiene related instructions **must be followed**.
- Instructions given for who children play and socialise with **must be followed**.
- Children must remain in areas specified by staff.
- Children and adults should try to cover their mouths when coughing or sneezing (into the elbow is best) and will be reminded by staff regularly to "catch it, bin it, kill it".
- Children will let a member of staff know if they are feeling unwell as soon as possible.
- Children must remain with the groups they are in as much as possible.
- Spitting / coughing / sneezing at or towards another person will not be tolerated. Deliberate endangering of others will result in sanctions, potentially being sent home.
- The school may contact you and ask you to speak to your child or visit the school if their behaviour is inappropriate, defiant, or puts others at risk.

This is to be read alongside the current behaviour policy which is an interim document and will be updated July 2020.
