Dear parents and carers,

It is with deep regret that we have no alternative but to change the school timings this week. This is due to the lower numbers of staff in school. There will also be no breakfast or after school club available until further notice as we do not have staff to run them. The Nursery will be closed until further notice.

We will be taking vulnerable and critical worker children if needed for the whole day. The temporary revised school timings are as follows:

Reception: 9.00am-12.30pm

KS1: 8.55-12.45

Years 3 & 4: 8.50-12.40 Year 5: 8.45- 12.45 Year 6: 8.40-12.45

Children will stay for lunch before being collected. We will continue to provide children with a hot school dinner if you have ordered them via the Aspens website. Remote learning will take place in the afternoons. This will also be reviewed at the end of the week.

Only SEND students with an ECHP, looked after students or otherwise vulnerable count as being part of this key group.

Critical workers are defined by the government primarily as those in teaching, care, medical or emergency services. Full guidance can be found here:
