## Reminder of Covid 19 symptoms

These are the three main symptoms of coronavirus. If you get just one of them, you should get a test.

- New and continuous cough - coughing a lot for more than an hour, or having three or more coughing episodes in 24 hours.
- Fever - a temperature above 37.8C.
- Change in smell or taste: either you cannot taste or smell anything, or these senses are different to normal.

We do have a supply of LFD kits if you are struggling to get any. Please contact the office.

## Housekeeping Reminders

- If your child is unwell please call or email the office by 9am so that we are aware your child will not be in school/nursery that day.
- Please remember doors open at 8:45am. If your child's door entrance is shut they must come into school through the main office. Lessons start promptly so please make sure your child is on time.
- Any routine medical/dental appointments should be booked after school hours when possible so children do not lose learning time
- Please **DO NOT** park on the yellow lines at drop off/collection times as this is dangerous for children who wish to cross the road.
- No smoking/vaping is permitted on school grounds **at any time.**

## Pupil Premium

If your child is eligible for pupil premium there are numerous benefits including free school meals (even beyond Year 2) Even if your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 and currently receives a free school meal under the 'Universal free school meal' government scheme, it is important that you apply for Pupil premium if you think you may be eligible.
